



THE SCOTIA CHALLENGE 2020

Registration for the Scotia Challenge and payment of £10 entry fee is required to participate in this event. The fee is to cover the cost of awards on completion of the event. The awards structure will be as follows:

ENTRY BIKE IS OLDER THAN 40YRS:

Platinum is awarded for 45 checkpoints on a bike over 40 years old on 1/1/2019, then Gold for 30, Silver for 15.

ENTRY BIKE IS OLDER THAN 15YRS:

Gold is awarded for 45 checkpoints on a bike over 15 years old on 1/1/2019, Silver for 30, Bronze for 15.

ENTRY BIKE IS YOUNGER THAN 15YRS:

Any bike used is younger than 15 on 1/1/2019 – it's Silver for 45, and Bronze for 30.

- If more than 1 bike is entered, any award will be based on the age of the most modern - see above.
- Start as soon as you like. Claims and photo evidence should be returned to Ian Bell at the address below by end of October for an awards presentation at the Christmas Dinner in December. Remember bike must feature in your checkpoint photo.
- Send completed registration form (below) to Ian Bell, Jai Tegan, Station Road, Errol, PH2 7SN. In return you will receive the list of checkpoints. These will be emailed out on the 1st March. If you wish to start planning earlier, send an email indicating your intention to register to ian.bell51@btinternet.com and the list of checkpoints will be emailed by return.
